Health & Safety Policy

Belmont Parish Council is committed to ensuring, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety, and welfare of its employees, councillors, volunteers, contractors, and members of the public. The Council will comply with all relevant legislation, maintain safe premises and equipment, carry out and review risk assessments, provide appropriate training and information, and record and investigate accidents and near misses.

The Parish Clerk is responsible for the day-to-day management of health and safety arrangements. All employees, councillors, and volunteers must follow safety procedures, use equipment correctly, and report hazards or incidents promptly. Contractors working on behalf of the Council must adhere to safe working practices and cooperate with the Council's requirements.

This policy will be reviewed annually or sooner if circumstances require.
